About Evan Rennie



Evan has always been an active fun loving boy. He loves all things outdoors and sports: hunting, ice fishing, open-water fishing, football, baseball, and running. We have attended this event in past years, and it was such a wonderful afternoon for my boys. Owen still talks about the joke fish pulled up (I think it was a toy alligator!). We have also won some of the great raffle baskets, and the kids loved them.

In September 2022, Evan started complaining of headaches. He was going to the school office to rest instead of going out to recess. He wanted to lay in bed and skip the youth deer hunt. He was not himself! On October 19th Evan had an MRI, and we were told to get to the ER immediately.

Evan was diagnosed with a brain tumor and excessive fluid building up around his brain. He subsequently had multiple surgeries to drain the fluid and remove the tumor. His family was told he would be in the hospital for three weeks and that he would need therapy to regain speech and coordination. He defied the odds and was out of the hospital in 1 week with no therapy needed.

However, within an hour of being home, the family was told his tumor was malignant. Evan had a cancerous medulloblastoma removed, but the cancer cells were still there. A week after hearing that news, Evan had a spinal tap and port placed. Evan receives radiation and chemotherapy weekly at Lurie Children's Hospital and Northwestern Proton Center. Chemotherapy once a week and radiation five times a week for six weeks. Evan and one parent were in Warrenville, Illinois, while the other parent and Evan's two younger siblings were home trying to keep as normal of a routine as possible. Maintenance chemotherapy will be scheduled for about nine months.
